#### **Statement of nature and significance of vegetation to be protected**

This area contains Glen Eira's only remaining significant remnant indigenous plant community which makes a positive contribution to the locality's former ecology and landscape.

Forty-four (44) mature River Red Gums form the integrity of the open space reserve. A total of twenty-nine (29) species of indigenous plants, remnant of a River Red Gum Woodland Community which once covered large areas of Glen Eira and Melbourne, are supported in the reserve.
