WOODEND BUSH RURAL LIVING PRECINCT

1.0

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Neighbourhood character objectives

To encourage dwellings that integrate with the topography and informal bush setting of the area.

To maintain semi-rural streetscapes with rural style fencing and informal road treatments.

To maintain the semi-rural interface between the large bush lots located south of the township boundary and the more densely developed residential parts of Woodend.

To conserve vegetation as the dominant characteristic with the retention of large canopy trees.

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Minimum subdivision area

The minimum lot size for subdivision is 2,000 square metres.

Minimum street setback	A3 and B6	10 metres unless: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ there are existing buildings on both adjoining lots facing the front street, in which case the setback should be the average distance of the setbacks of the front walls of the existing buildings on the abutting lots, whichever is the lesser ▪ there is a dwelling on one abutting lot, in which case the setbacks can be the same as the dwelling on the abutting lot facing the front street, whichever is the lesser
Site coverage	A5 and B8	20 per cent
Permeability	A6 and B9	30 per cent
Landscaping	B13	In addition to the requirements of B13, development should provide for at least two canopy trees. At least one of those trees should be in the dwelling or residential building's front garden
Side and rear setbacks	A10 and B17	A new building not on or within 200mm of a boundary should be setback 5 metres plus 0.3 metres for every metre of building height over 3.6 metres up to 6.9 metres, plus 1 metre for every metre of building height over 6.9 metres
