ROADSIDE VEGETATION PROTECTION AREA

1.0

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Statement of nature and significance of vegetation to be protected

Roadsides throughout the municipality contain important species of remnant native vegetation which contribute to the environmental qualities of the area and which act as important wildlife corridors.

This schedule relates to the following roadsides:

- Calder Highway, Merbein West, between Paschendale Avenue and Sanders Street
- Sturt Highway, Merbein, between Meridian Road and McCarthys Road
- Danes Road, Karadoc

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Decision Guidelines

- The purpose of native vegetation removal or destruction and the need to seek alternatives to native vegetation removal or destruction.
- The flora and fauna significance of native vegetation.
- Objectives and principles of relevant regional vegetation plans, regional catchment strategies, Victorian Native Vegetation Framework and Victoria's Biodiversity Strategy.
- Any relevant roadside management plan.
